



Week of: June 7 - 9 , 2010

Language Arts: We will continue Theme 10: We Can Do It. The Strategy focus for the week is to summarize what students read, and in comprehension, we will be working on the sequence of events. In phonics, students will be reading words with -r controlled vowels (or, ar, er, ir, ur). **Spelling words contain words with -ar endings.** High Frequency Words are begin, minute, already, above, against, caught. In grammar, students will be using describing words for taste, smell, and feel.

*End of the year reading assessments will continue this week!

Math: We will continue with Unit 10 on measurement in math this week. Students will continue to build on the understanding of inches and centimeters as units of length. Children will take an active role in the measuring process by positioning rulers to objects and recording the data. They will also learn to record measurements in tables.

Social Studies: We will continue and wrap up Unit 4: Changes Over Time. This week students will learn how travel has changed over time. Students will also discuss how they can learn about the past. **Students will take the unit test next Tuesday.**
